

Guadalupe. All are invited! You won't want to miss it!



After the Sunday Mass in Virden, there will be a Business Meeting with the



Bishop when he will meet with the Finance Council, parish leaders, and staff from all three parishes to discuss the parish's implementation of the directives from the Diocesan Synod. This will not be a meeting for the general parish because of it's formal, business nature but we do ask for prayers for all who are preparing for the meeting. We will have some slight changes to the regular schedule of Masses for that weekend, so please watch the bulletins for the announcement. 
